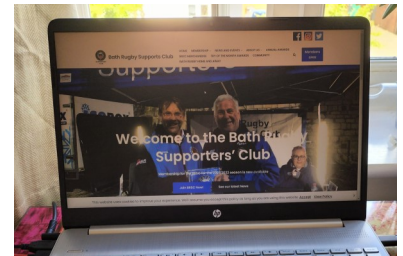
As the meeting got underway, Doug Wrigglesworth, BRSC Chair, announced the appointment of John Hall as our new Club President, and welcomed him to the AGM.

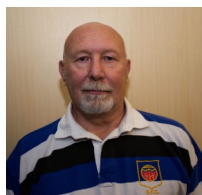
John's international debut was in 1984 and he gained 21 caps during his 10-year international career.

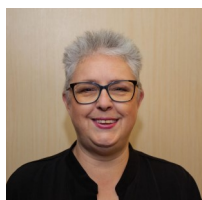

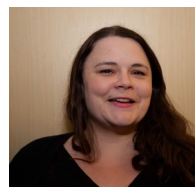

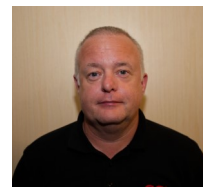
