Bath Rugby have been fortunate enough to accommodate some of the players that were without a team and we welcome them warmly to the Blue, Black and White family.

While the future format of Premiership rugby is currently uncertain, we can rest assured that while Bath results may not be what we had hoped for so far, we have a Club with a stable financial future.

This position is only enhanced by the recent Supreme Court decision that the proposed development at The Rec can proceed without any further objections relating to the 1922 Covenants. This is fantastic news for all involved in the redevelopment scheme and should help secure the future of rugby at The Rec.

Bath Rugby fans who stayed to watch the Double Header on 22/10/2022 were delighted with two wins in one day as not only did the boys in Blue, Black & White secure their first win of the season beating Northampton Saints 27–14, the Ladies claimed their 4th win by trouncing Old Albanian Saints 33–0. So far this season the Ladies first XV is unbeaten which is an impressive track record for a recently promoted team who could well be on the way to a further promotion at the end of the season!



You may have seen in the news that Bath Rugby have recently agreed the sale of some unused land at Lambridge Training Ground to Lidl. What the headlines may not have explained is that Bath Rugby have gifted the remaining land and buildings to Bath RFC, the amateur club which is home to the Bath Rugby Ladies and junior teams. This allows Bath RFC autonomy to make plans for a long-term future at Lambridge and build on their current success.

This event is “sold out”. Tickets were snapped up very quickly. However you can join the waiting list, should we get any returns.

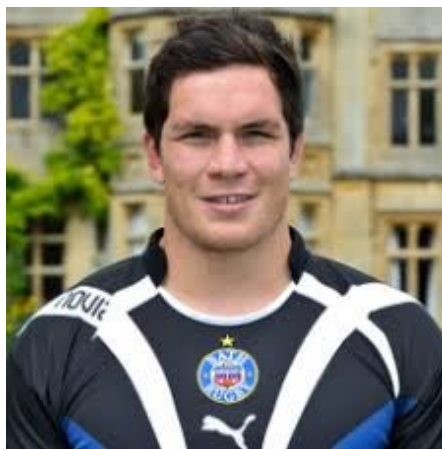
This is a free to members event. Full details are on our website.
