Bath Rugby Supporters' Club (BRSC)

BRSC is one of the largest independent rugby supporters' clubs dating back over 25 years, having been formed in 1997, some 18 months after the game turned professional. Our aim then was to maintain links between the club, its players and the supporters during the amorphic period of early professionalism.

Prior to the game turning professional, rugby clubs relied upon their volunteers to act as an integral part of the club's management and structure - Bath Rugby was no different. Post professionalism brought new challenges to both the supporters and the clubs – the potential for a disconnect between the two was obvious and thus Bath Rugby Supporters' Club came into existence.

BRSC is and always has been, independent from Bath Rugby, a supporters' club run by supporters. Today we exist to identify, understand and promote the interests of Bath Rugby and our Members, providing services and activities for all who support Bath Rugby.

We are proud of our status as an independent supporters' club, and we are a separate entity from Bath Rugby Club with a separate membership scheme. We enjoy an excellent, and much appreciated working relationship with Bath Rugby.

We have a matchday gazebo, located in the supporter's village, which is staffed at each home game, from when the gates open to 30 mins before kick-off.

BRSC recognises and maintains a close working relationship with Bath Rugby, Bath Rugby Foundation, and the Bath Rugby Ladies teams. We provide feedback to the main club from a supporters' perspective, raise funds for the Foundation and actively support and sponsor the Ladies' teams.

Charity Work

BRSC is proud of its fund-raising efforts and our members have generously donated to our chosen charities over the years. Last season we reinvigorated our charitable efforts which saw a very credible £3200 raised, a figure that was double our last pre-pandemic amount. We began a new partnership with Bath Rugby Foundation at the start of the 2023-24 season and they have become our permanent charity for the foreseeable future.

The bulk of our fundraising derives from raffles and a Lottery, and we are very grateful to Bath Rugby and local businesses who provide us with such fabulous prizes. Last season our portfolio of prizes included signed rugby shirts, hospitality with the Bath Rugby President, tickets for WOMAD 2024, a tour of Farleigh House and a tour of Peter Gabriel's recording studio in Corsham. In all we had nearly 30 prizes that members won, last season.

BRSC Events

BRSC organises a variety of rugby specific events that are either free (to members) or have a small cover charge. Some of our recent events have been:

Annual Awards. The BRSC Awards evening is the highlight of our season. Each year we give out a number of awards, 7 of which go to players from Bath Rugby and Bath Rugby Ladies, these include, amongst others, Player of the Season, Try of the Season and Young Player of the Season. We announce the winner and where possible present the award in person at the Awards dinner. Tickets for the dinner, normally, held in August, have become a much sort after commodity and the evening provides our members with the opportunity to meet the players and coaches in a relaxed convivial environment.

Matchday Presence

BRSC has a gazebo that is staffed at each home game. This is located on the outfield near the Swift Half.
