

Annual Awards Dinner 2025

This was a wonderful evening, held on the 14th of August at the Doubletree by Hilton Over 150 people (BRSC Members, Sponsors, Players and Coaches) attended the dinner. The highlight was having all three of our trophies on display and each member was given the opportunity to have a photograph of themselves with the trophies!

The attending players had their table numbers drawn out of a hat and then took the seats. Tom Dunn raised a laugh by carrying the Gallagher Premiership Cup in and putting it on his table, swapping it for the table decoration! We were informed later that as it was the last Gallagher Premiership Cup (we now have the Gallagher PREM Cup) we would, as the final winning team, be allowed to keep the cup in our trophy cabinet (where, we trust, it will be joined by the new cup in 2026!)

After a delicious meal, we had a silent auction for bottles of wine signed by players and David Trick was the Auctioneer for the prize of a balloon ride, which raised £700! This was followed by the Awards Ceremony where the players each received a trophy (which they had to hand back to be kept in the BRSC trophy cabinet in the Clubhouse) together with an engraved Welsh Slate they could keep, as well as a voucher".

The Stone King Award for services to BRSC & Bath Rugby was awarded (in a surprise visit earlier in the week) to Tarquin McDonald. A special memento was given to Johann van Graan in recognition of his work over the last two years which had such an impact. (Italics = Sponsors)

The Cup for the Impact Player of the Season is a new one in memory of Issy Hogg. I was fortunate to meet Issy last year, a few months before she died, and even in the few hours we spent together she became one of the people who will always be an inspiration to me. We had a wonderful discussion on so many topics, many quite deep or emotional. This cup is an apt tribute to this amazing lady who had such an impact herself.

Speeches were given by our Secretary David Harrington and David Trick, with a few words from the Chair (Doug Wrigglesworth) and the evening's organiser Karen Willetts. We were then thrilled that Johann van Graan asked to speak and after listening to him we have even more hopes for the coming season.

Much organisation goes into these events and we would like to thank the staff at the hotel and the members of the committee (and their families!) who worked very hard to set things up and a special mention to Karen for her superb organisation of a very successful and enjoyable evening.

Bath Rugby Foundation was set up in November 2003 to give back to the local community, by coaching rugby to young people from disadvantaged backgrounds. Later it became obvious that the delivery programmes needed to be changed to fit the challenges of all the less fortunate areas of the city.

The coaches aim to enhance the lives of young people through sport; to motivate, raise self-esteem, increase confidence and improve life skills by imparting the values found in rugby - camaraderie, loyalty, discipline and respect.

Based at The Rec Sports Hub since 2017 the staff, trustees and partners are committed to giving all young people an equal opportunity. BRSC are proud to support them and this last year we raised the magnificent sum of £6396.52 to do so.
